PYRN Russia meeting

On February 26, 2015, the PYRN Russia meeting (#30) was organized in Moscow. During the meeting there were 2 lectures presented: The first was titled "Development of the research stations on Bely Island, Yamal and Gyda Peninsulas. Plans and prospects". Research and exploring stations were established on the territory of the Yamal-Nenets autonomous district in the beginning of 2015. They will carry out research work on environmental and ecological monitoring, biological resources. The speaker was Vladimir Pushkarev from Russian Centre of Arctic Development.

The second lecture was conducted by Pavel Orekhov from Earth Cryosphere Institute SB RAS. The theme of his lecture was: "Complex research station on Belyy island: History, Present and Prospects."

There were about 12 PYRs on the meeting, who were active in their questions to lecturers and informal conversation after the lectures. Online broadcasting and lectures recording was also organized.

The title of the PYRN workshop at EGU this year is "Short Workshop for early career scientists: Permafrost in a changing climate" and is a joint effort between PYRN and APECS. This year the focus is on the results of studies by young researchers, covering topics that range from climate change and permafrost modeling to consequences of permafrost degradation on the landscape and on the society e.g. through infrastructure.

45th International Arctic Workshop, Bergen/Norway, 10-13 May

The workshop is an annual gathering of international researchers working on any aspect of high-latitude environments consisting of a series of talks and poster sessions in a rather informal atmosphere. Previous Arctic Workshops have included presentations on arctic climate, glaciology, environmental geochemistry, geomorphology, hydrology, soils, ecology, oceanography, and Quaternary history.

Registration for student presenters is NOK 300, students can apply for free accommodation (first come, first serve) and travel support. The deadline for

IGU Regional Conference 2015, Moscow, Russian Federation, August 17-21, 2015


